Camp Includes:

~ **One hour of a group riding lesson**~ group lessons not to exceed three students at a time, all lessons are geared directly towards level of students abilities.

~ **Learning Groups** ~ All campers will be divided into groups of two or three according to their level or age. Each group will be assigned to two horses that they are responsible for grooming and stall cleaning throughout the week.

~ **Curriculum** ~ Campers will learn a variety of horse related facts by doing worksheets and participating in hands on activities to broaden their knowledge of riding and training of horses, horse safety, caring for horses, and horse health awareness.

~ **Arts and Crafts** ~ Campers will also do an art project throughout the week so that they have a creation of their own to remember camp by.

~ **Demo Day** ~ Advanced weeks only - There will be a special demonstration and clinic provided by a professional in the industry.

~ **Field Trip** - Campers will be taken on a field trip to Weathervane Tack Shop in Tiverton, RI where they will have a project to present and will be able to do a little shopping.

~ **Additional Weekly Activities** ~ Bath Day, Tack Cleaning Day, Horse-Less Horse Show

~ **Test and Show Day** ~ On the last day of camp, campers will be tested on the material learned throughout the week. Also, the campers will be involved in a "fun show" where the kids will be able to show off what they learned on the horse through horseback games and classes judged on their position and control of the horse. Advanced Camp will perform in a horse show that is associated with the weeks focus. A rated judge will be brought in to judge and critic this show. Ribbons and prizes are awarded for all weeks. Parents are welcome to attend this day.

What to Bring to Camp?

~ Change of clothing, shorts are recommended for daytime activity

~ Bagged lunch: include an extra drink and snack or money for the soda machine

~ Jeans, or proper riding pants to change into for riding time.

~ Rubber sole boots or riding shoes with a slight 1/2 inch heel. No sneakers or sandals please.

~ Any other riding equipment student may have: gloves, helmets, saddles, etc. - not required.

~ **Advanced Camp Only** - Riders are required to wear proper riding attire: breeches/jodhpurs, tall or paddock boots, helmet, gloves, hairnets. Proper show attire is required on the last day of camp week.

ASTME/SEI CERTIFIED HELMETS ARE REQUIRED AND ARE PROVIDED IF CHILD DOES NOT HAVE THEIR OWN.

Staff: All camp counselors are CPR and First Aid Certified.
